



El Dorado United Competitive Club Volunteer Commitment Program



It takes a great deal of volunteer effort and fundraising to run a successful competitive soccer program. We have a Volunteer Commitment Program in our Club to ensure that our program runs smoothly. Therefore every player must help by providing adult volunteers for a minimum of 10 volunteer hours for the Club during the soccer season. If you have more than one child playing in our Club then you must volunteer for a minimum of 15 hours. The time period for the program is from tryouts in 2005 to December 1st, 2005. These volunteer hours for the Club are not to be confused with volunteer hours that you may need to do to help your individual teams. Some team volunteer positions qualify for Club volunteer hours (see below).

The Volunteer Commitment Program fee is \$50 due June 1st. When the volunteer hours for each player are completed, your volunteer fee will be returned to you. It is your responsibility to ensure that your hours are recorded and you receive the credit toward the work that you performed. Make sure that you fill out the volunteer sheets and have an authorized signature. If you do not complete the minimum number of hours, your volunteer fee is forfeited. If you do not want to participate in the Volunteer Commitment Program, you can donate your volunteer fee. If so, just note it below.

- _____ Referee: Referee an El Dorado game without pay (must be a certified referee).

Most of your volunteer hours can be filled at our tournaments held in August. Once the season is underway, your team will have a Tournament Committee member. You can get hours from your Tournament Committee representative.

You can also get sponsors for the Club to offset your volunteer hours. For every \$50 you get donated to the Club, you will get credit for 1 hours of volunteer work. See attached Club Sponsorship form for sponsorship packages.
